

Mother Veronica (Miss Sophie Leeves, born on October 1, 1823), Foundress of the Sisters of the Apostolic Carmel, Mangalore, Karnataka, India, was deeply religious and highly intellectual, an English woman attracted by Christ, gave her entire life to God. In 1868 the Apostolic Carmel was established in Bayonne, France, and in 1870, in India. Her mission was to educate and empower the women in India.

OUR FOUNDER

The College was founded in 1940 and is conducted by the Sisters of the Apostolic Carmel, an indigenous Religious Educational Body founded in 1870. Bishop B.J. Sullivan S.J., Patna, a visionary, sought their support to start a College for women in Bihar. Mother Josephine A.C., the then Superior General of the Congregation, responded. Consequently the first College for women was founded in Bihar.

I. CURRICULAR ASPECTS

The curriculum forms the core of any educational programme, providing the foundation for academic growth and shaping the career pathways of learners. In alignment with current trends followed by major Indian universities and in accordance with NAAC guidelines, Patna Women's College has implemented **Outcome Based Education (OBE)** across all its academic programmes.

Each curriculum has been thoughtfully developed to address global, national, regional, and local developmental priorities, ensuring that learners gain knowledge and skills relevant to their context. The structured and comprehensive design reflects educational goals, industry expectations, and societal requirements, helping students acquire essential competencies. Additionally, provisions for innovation, experiential learning, and value-based education offer flexibility and enrichment. Notably, all the programmes incorporate Research Projects, Fieldwork, or Internships as integral components of the curriculum.

PWC adopted NEP-2020 based curriculum in 2023 for all UG programmes. In 2025 **two new PG programmes M.A. in History and M.A. in Economics; and one new UG programme B.Sc. in Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics (Hons.)** were introduced.

II. TEACHING-LEARNING AND EVALUATION

Patna Women's College follows student-centric teaching-learning practices supported by a robust and reliable evaluation system. Experiential, participatory and problem-solving approaches are integrated at every stage of learning. ICT-enabled tools and a customized Learning Management System further enhance the teaching learning process. Students' learning levels are assessed through academic evaluations and teacher rating checklists. Remedial classes are organized for slow learners, while advanced learners are encouraged to engage in research presentations, inter-university exchange programmes and various institutional activities. Each department implements a structured Mentoring System, through which students receive support for career planning, academic development and personal concerns.

The Examination Management System incorporates modern IT solutions such as ERP, PWC-LINK LMS and an Automated Question Bank Management System aligned with Advanced Bloom's Taxonomy. In accordance with the college's OBE framework, Course Outcomes are systematically mapped to Programme Outcomes to ensure effective achievement of learning outcomes and graduate attributes.

III. RESEARCH, INNOVATION AND EXTENSION

The institution is dedicated to foster a strong research culture and has developed ample facilities to support high-quality research and innovation. The college offers robust infrastructure and supportive resources that encourage research among both faculty and students. Well-equipped subject-specific laboratories with modern instruments, along with computer labs equipped with academic software, enable the pursuit of quality research. To promote interdisciplinary work and provide access to advanced equipment, the college has established a Central Research Laboratory and a Research Centre. The Central Library further strengthens research activities with its rich collection of books and access to various e-resources.

Research Seed Money is allocated to motivate faculty members for undertaking meaningful and innovative research. To nurture research interest among students, selected candidates are awarded Research Scholarships that support their involvement in research projects, publications and related activities. The institution publishes three peer-reviewed journals annually. The college's extension services are also highly active, with faculty and students regularly participating in community outreach programmes, particularly aimed at supporting marginalized sections of society.

1. Title of the Best Practice: PWC-PRAYAS (Promotion of Responsible Action for Youth and Society)

2. Objectives of the Practice: Patna Women's College has undertaken **PWC-PRAYAS (Promotion of Responsible Action for Youth and Society)** under **Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR)** through different social outreach programmes and support services especially meant for the marginalized sections of the society. The basic objective of the practice is to provide assistance, remedial classes, financial aid and psychological support to the different categories of marginalized and underprivileged sections of the society and also to the needy students of our college. All the students of Patna Women's College involved in various ISR initiatives have the opportunity to earn a maximum of **4 Non-Academic Credits**.

The chief objectives of PWC-PRAYAS are:

- To inculcate the values of compassion, moral responsibility and social service among the students of the institution
- To identify the underprivileged groups of the society for reaching out to them
- To provide financial, moral, educational and psychological support the target groups at regular basis
- To empower the target groups with skill development and employment opportunities

- 3. The Context:** PWC-PRAYAS has taken shape adhering to the objectives of the college that reads 'to be committed to selfless service to the economically, socially, psychologically and spiritually deprived'. The mission statement of the college emphasizes on to train the students in social service and to create women leaders for social change. The practice of social outreach follows the institutional core value of 'Social Responsibility and Empowerment of the Marginalized'.
- 4. The Practice:** Patna Women's College has undertaken its community outreach by the following ISR initiatives under the banner of **PWC – PRAYAS (Promotion of Responsible Action for Youth and Society)**:

Inter College Women Association (ICWA): ICWA is an Inter-college initiative for the upliftment of children and women belonging to marginalized sections of our society. ICWA volunteers of the college under the guidance of teachers undertake literacy campaigns and social upliftment programmes in the neighbourhood areas for the slum children and women. At the same time ICWA provides services related to health, sanitation and rehabilitation to the inmates of Women's Remand Home.

Manthan Project: Under this outreach programme, the student volunteers provide remedial teaching to the underprivileged school children at NGO Manthan, Khagaul. The students visit the centre on Saturdays to train the children in their school subjects.

Mother Veronica Development Foundation (MVDF): This scheme supports the economically backward meritorious students of the college through remedial teaching, library facilities, English communication, personality development sessions and skill development training.

Joy of Giving: Every year as a philanthropic effort the **Joy of Giving** Week is observed in the college. The students and staff collect cash and needful items during the week that is distributed among the poor, disaster victims, orphans, destitute women and leprosy patients.

School Mentorship Programme: PWC runs a mentorship programme in the 20 government secondary schools of Patna. Under this programme different departments have been assigned with mentee schools. The students under the guidance of ISR Coordinators provide classroom teaching and support in other co-curricular/ extra-curricular activities.

Scholarships: PWC has instituted following scholarship for continuing the studies of the students. Platinum Jubilee Foundation Scholarship, Mother Veronica Development Foundation (MVDF), Freeship, PWC Helping Hand Scholarship, PWC Research Scholarship, PWC Examination Scholarship.

REDS Project (Ragpickers Education & Development Scheme): Under this outreach programme, the student volunteers provide remedial teaching to the children of the ragpickers at Charminade Institution, Digha. The volunteers visit the institution to train the children in their school subjects, conduct sport activities and orient them on sanitation issues.

IT Cell at Garima Grah, Khagaul: An IT Cell has been furnished by the college with computers and other necessities at Garima Grah, a hostel for the transgender community members. The student volunteers visit the aforesaid hostel on Saturdays to conduct IT classes for the transgender friends providing them with the basic IT knowledge.

Outreach Programmes for marginalized groups: For underprivileged people like rickshaw pullers, house maids, rag pickers and Transgender friends, every year special **Christmas Milan programmes** are organized. Many other welfare measures are undertaken for them from time to time.

Asha Kiran Shelter Home, Notre Dame Academy, Patna: The Department of Political Science has collaboration with Asha Kiran under Each One Teach One programme. The students of the Department not only engage classes for the students of Asha Kiran but also celebrate important days like International Women's Day, Independence Day and Deepawali with them.

Best Practice No. 2

- 1. Title of the Best Practice:** CARMEL COMMUNITY COLLEGE – An alternative education system for non-collegiate women
- 2. Objectives and Principles:** Carmel Community College is functioning in the PWC Campus with its sole principle to impart employability-oriented education to those women of our society who are either deprived from the conventional college education or are school/college drop-outs.

The chief objectives of the Carmel community college are:

- To evolve an alternative system of education for the less privileged women
- To focus on livelihood-based and employability centred training
- To enhance competency level, skill development and entrepreneurship skills among the trainees
- To develop strong Industry-Institution linkages for securing employment for the students
- To empower the marginalized women

- 3. The Context:** In the light of the vision and mission statement of the institution, the Carmel Community College has been established to promote skill-oriented courses for empowerment of the marginalized women. The education system is contextually meant for facilitating professional skill-based practical training to those young women who are unable to get into conventional academic programmes due to some kind of unfavourable circumstances.
- 4. The Practice:** Carmel Community College offers 3 skill-oriented courses namely (i) **Health Care**, (ii) **Beauty Care** and (iii) **Tailoring**. The minimum educational qualification required for undertaking these courses are Higher Secondary/ Matriculation. At the same time the girls/women must have knack in the concerned field of study and an entrepreneurship zeal.

Health Care is a 6-month course containing both theory and practical topics. The course includes fundamentals of nursing, personal hygiene, identification and control of infections, bio-medical waste management and preventive health care. The students are also trained practically about oral health cares, medications, patient care and handling patients, managing bed sores, preparing beds, and working on common medical care instruments.

Beauty Care is a 3-month course emphasising on the basic skills of a beautician. The course of study includes bridal make-up, hair care and styling, manicure, pedicure, skin care techniques of bleaching and

waxing, threading, etc. The students receive both theory as well as practical training and become well trained for working in beauty salons and also for starting their own business.

Tailoring is a 6-month course providing hands-on training in needle work, cut work, stitching, cutting and tailoring. The students learn popular needle work stitches for preparing different craft items. They receive training for cutting and stitching common outfits like blouse, salwar, kurti, frock, petticoat, baby suit, etc. They are trained in working on sewing machines. They learn different types of cut work techniques such as patch work, applique, sequin work and beading.

Entrepreneurship Promotion

The objective of Entrepreneurship Promotion is to inspire and work with aspiring entrepreneurs to shape up business ideas into commercial start-up companies. Under the guidance of diligent and experienced faculty, candidates learn the dynamic process of business development and how to survive in their early stage. In addition, the institution also provides infrastructural support i.e. office space, meeting room to the candidates. At every step, the individuals are mentored and nurtured for their acquiescent business ideas.

Earning while learning: Many of our students earn while they continue their study in the college. The mode of earning includes part-time teaching, giving tuitions, writing for newspapers, freelancing, reporting and anchoring, working at call centres, etc. The break-up of the number of students who earn while they learn is given below.



Department of Hindi

Department of Hindi was established in 1941 and the Honours programme started in 1954. The department offers the undergraduate programme in Hindi and a Course in Creative Writing in Hindi under VAC. Department of English

The Department of English was established in the same year as Patna Women's College. The department offers undergraduate and post-graduate programmes. It also offers six credit based Add-on Courses: three in foreign languages; German, French and Spanish and three in Performing Arts; Dance, Drama and Music.

The department aims at creating a learning environment that is conducive to the development of critical faculty and shaping of socially responsible and committed citizens with human values and ethical practices. The department focuses not only on imparting curriculum-based theoretical knowledge but also on sensitising students towards important issues and subjects so that the acquired learning translates into positive social intervention.



Department of Geography

The Department of Geography was established in the year 1941 with Intermediate teaching. Presently the department is offering UG (Honours) and PG Programmes under semester system based on NEP-2020 curriculum with Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The teaching-learning process is up to date in the department with well-qualified faculty, regular usage of ICT based teaching aids and modern Learning Management System (LMS). Department of Psychology

Department of Psychology was established in 1966. Presently, it offers B.A. in Psychology with National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, CBCS and M.A. in Applied Psychology. Department of Home Science

The Department of Home Science started in 1940 with intermediate-level courses. It grew over time, adding undergraduate program in 1966 and postgraduate program in 1982. Today, it stands as one of the college's oldest departments, offering comprehensive education in Home Science. The program combines practical skills, professional training, and creative thinking to help students succeed in their careers.

The curriculum gives students a solid foundation through diverse subjects. Students gain knowledge in diverse fields like: food outlet management, cooking, poster making, textile crafts, pattern making, drafting, cutting and stitching, and technical laboratory work including textile testing, physiology, dyeing, and printing. They also visit commercial institutions and NGOs for practical exposure. This approach blends theory with practice while teaching entrepreneurial skills. The department has a library with 879 books that support the learning needs of students and teachers.

A self-financed B.Sc. program in Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics commenced this year, which has been performing well. The department also runs an additional course in Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics to promote learning across different disciplines. The departmental club 'Zaika' - The Cookery Club organizes various programs at the college level, promoting culinary creativity and skill development among students.

Our students have consistently performed well, winning gold medals and honors at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. Our teachers promote innovation and encourage students to start research early in their academic journey.

The department runs a Health Centre where doctors share their knowledge about medicine and healthcare. We regularly organize interactive sessions with experts from different fields to enhance learning for both students and faculty.

Efforts are put to coach students in different skills through Mock Interviews and Group Discussions in collaboration with experts from institutes like International School of Business & Media Studies and Pune Institute of Business Management, Kolkata. The department conducts regular workshops with RBI which provides students an opportunity to gain insights into banking and digital literacy as well. We also organize career counselling sessions regularly in order to guide students on career options available to them in their future endeavours.

Department of Mass Communication (BMC)

The Department of Mass Communication was established with the goal of giving young media aspirants a place to pursue their ambition. Research and academic activities focus on emerging interdisciplinary areas including Molecular Biology, Plant Biotechnology, Computational Biology, Environmental Biotechnology, and Nanobiotechnology. Only 5 univs, 74 colleges get NAAC accreditation

Putna: Recent economic survey has brought to light a glaring gap in the state's higher education sector. Despite an increase in the number of institutions, quality education remains a challenge.

According to the economic survey tabled by the Bihar govt in the state legislature, of the total 39 universities in 2023-24, only five got the NAAC accreditation. Only one university made it

under state legislative act and deemed university, and seven private universities. Apart from the Central University of South Bihar, which was given A++ grade, the other four received B++, B+, and C marking.

Similarly, the breakdown of colleges shows that one college each got A++, A+, and A grades, four each were given B++ and B+ marking, a maximum of 32 colleges were given B grades, followed by 27 which were given C marking, and four were

given D grades.

Academic advisor, Bihar State Higher Education Council, Nawin Kumar Agrawal, who was made state nodal officer, NAAC in 2023, said the number of educational institutions with NAAC accreditation came down because of the Covid-19 pandemic when many teachers were not coming to the colleges.

He said the NAAC accreditation is for five years, and most of the institutes completed their cycle in 2020, 21, or 22, at a time when online clas-

ses were mainly going on. He said many institutes could not apply for the new accreditation. He further said making an application is not a one-day exercise; rather, universities and colleges have to do documentation on a daily basis, and once a year, an annual quality assurance report is submitted.

He recalled how in 2016-17, Lalit Narayan Mithila University (LNMU) alone had 34 colleges which were accredited by the NAAC. "But now, we have deputed one person each in the university as well as in colleges for the purpose, and the number of accredited institutions will go up," said Agrawal.





The Coat of Arms


The Coat of Arms represents the nature of the dedication of the Carmelite Sisters to Women's Education. It has (i) a book and a hand, (ii) a cross with a Patli creeper, (iii) a shield, a cross and three stars. The book and the hand in the coat of arms are those of Saint Teresa of Avila (Spain), the Patron Saint of Patna Women's College.

The cross is a symbol of hope in times of suffering. The creeper encircling the cross is the Patli creeper, which is of this place, Patliputra. The creeper clinging to the cross tells us that it was with great difficulty that this College was built, that we must not leave unfinished any work because of obstacles and that knowledge gained from books is second hand knowledge. It is experience gained through difficulties that matures a person.

The third symbol (shield, cross, stars) is that of the Carmelite Order to which the Sisters of this College belong. The shield like mountain is Mount Carmel in Palestine over looking the Mediterranean Sea, hence the blue background. Mount Carmel stands for stability and power, the symbol of God's steadfast love. A cross on the summit of the mountain is the distinctive mark of the Carmelites. The two stars on either side of the cross represent the Greek and Latin eras through which the Order has survived. The star in the centre symbolises Mary whose protection the Carmelites seek. Below the symbols is the motto: 'Always Wise' (Latin : Semper Sapientiae)

The College Flag

The College has flag with a cream background having an exclusive coat of arms of its own in the centre and the name Patna Women's College written below the coat of arms. The cream colour symbolise discipline and simplicity.
