	Analysis of water quality was done by determining pH, TDS (Total
	Dissolved Solid), Conductivity, DO (Dissolved Oxygen) and BOD
	(Biological Oxygen Demand). The water quality of site II was poor
	as compared to site I, site III and site IV. The high value of BOD
	and DO suggests that purification may be necessary for domestic
	consumption.
