## SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

#### 1. Preamble

In keeping with its core value 'Social Responsibility and Empowerment', Patna Women's College (Autonomous) is committed to provide financial support to its students assisting in their academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. The Scholarship Policy will apply to all the students of Patna Women's College. Scholarship will be withdrawn from students who leave the college without completing their studies in the institution.

### 2. Objectives

The Scholarship Policy provides a broad framework and a set of standard norms to the students for applying and availing various scholarships during their academic sessions at Patna Women's College. The basic objectives of the policy are:

- To make the students aware about the existing government and institutional scholarships
- To disseminate information regarding the terms and conditions for availing the scholarships instituted by the college

## 3. Scholarships by Central and State Governments

- The students of Patna Women's College are free to apply and avail the scholarships provided by the Government of India and the State Government of Bihar; such as National Scholarship Portal (NSP) and Mukhyamantri Kanya Utthan Yojna; in condition of fulfilling the minimum requirements.
- The college will comply with the Prime Minister Special Scholarship Scheme for Jammu & Kashmir students.

#### 4. Institutional Initiatives

Patna Women's College has instituted several scholarships for its students under the following heads:

- a. Platinum Jubilee Foundation Scholarship: An annual scholarship of Rs. 15000.00 is instituted for a student whose family income is less than Rs. 300000/- per annum. A student will avail the Platinum Jubilee Scholarship Progressive at the fulfilment of minimum 75% attendance in a semester and a minimum of 6.0 SGPA in the End Semester Examination.
- b. Free ship: Full exemption of College Fees will be granted to meritorious students belonging to BPL (Below Poverty Line) families.
- c. Platinum Jubilee Foundation Freeship: An annual scholarship is instituted for a student whose family income is less than Rs. 300000/- per annum and who has lost the bread winner of the family. A student will avail the Platinum Jubilee Freeship (Progressive) at the fulfilment of minimum 75% attendance in a semester and a minimum of 6.0 SGPA in the End Semester Examination.
- d. Merit Scholarship: Every year the toppers of all the academic programmes conducted at Patna Women's College will receive the Merit Scholarships. The amount of the scholarship will vary as per bank interest rates.
- e. Mother Veronica Development Foundation (MVDF) Scholarship: An annual scholarship of Rs. 15000.00 will be given to each selected student on merit cum means basis.
- f. PWC Examination Scholarship: In every semester a scholarship of Rs. 500.00 each will be given as an examination fee waiver to the students who apply.
- g. PWC Research Scholarship: For conducting Research Project and writing Research Paper, a scholarship ranging between Rs. 1000.00 to Rs. 5000.00 will be given every year to each selected student.
- h. PWC Helping Hand Scholarship: Patna Women's College will provide financial assistance to the students once in a semester under the PWC Helping Hand Scholarship as per the following:
  - College and Hostel Fee Concession Rs. 5000.00 to Rs. 25000.00
  - Cultural and Sports Activities Rs. 500.00 to Rs. 1000.00
  - Academic needs (Books, Stationary, Projects, Printouts) –
     Rs. 1000.00 to Rs. 10000.00
  - Study Tour / Field Visit fee Concession Rs. 1000.00 to Rs. 10000.00
